iteratures. In order to achieve this integration, this paper argues that studies of men's health should b

e based on 'critical studies on men' which emerges from feminist theory. Critical studies on

men's health is then integrated into the broader explanatory options identified in the health

inequality literature in order to provide a more fulsome account of variance within men's health
