Title (EN): The Swedish National Survey of Public Health

Abstract description (EN):

Since 2004 the Swedish National Institute of Public Health (SNIPH) in collaboration with a number of regional councils and Statistics Sweden have carried out a national survey of public health. The aim of the survey is to assess the health situation of the Swedish population and monitor changes that may occur in the state of health of the popula

tion over time. This is a random sample survey addressed to 20000 people in the age group 16- 84 years old. The survey comprises 75 questions. These questions cover various health areas such as physical and mental health, young people's health, elderly health, living conditions and lifestyle, work environment, safety at work, social relationships, use of medication, . Results give an overview of the health situation of the population and health discrepancies in different groups from di

fferent parameters such as a sexual, ethnical, socio - economical, disability perspective. The survey constitutes a valuable yardstick for decisions makers and all actors in the area of public health.
