Cervical Check - The National Cervical Screening Programme was made available to the 1.1 million eligible women aged 25 to 60 on 1 September 2008. The programme provides free smear tests every three years to women aged 25 to 44. Following two consecutive 'no abnormality detected' results, women aged 45 to 60 are screened every five years. Women can arrange an appointment to have a free smear test with a Cervical Check registered smear-taker (doctor or practice nurse) of their choice at a time and date convenient for them. To date Cervical Check has registered over 4,150 smear-takers (GPs, practice nurses and medical practitioners) in over 1,400 locations nationwide.
