Title (EN): State organized and paid programme for early diagnostic of breast cancer.

Abstract description (EN):

One of the main targets of this programme is to reduce cancer caused mortality. According to recent data, breast cancer in Latvia is one of the most frequent cancer forms, that can be fully cured, if detected timely. In that way quality of life can be improved. Since 2009 every year Health Payment centre from the Population register selects women, who are 50,52, 54, 56, 58, 60, 62, 64, 66, 68 years old, and sends them invitation letters. During 2 years (2009-2010) there were 286 785 invitation letters sent, 20% of invited women responded.
