Background



Healthcare should be **accessible** in a timely way to every patient who needs it, not only to those who can pay and regardless of gender, age, employment and residence status. Regrettably, **this is not a reality for all.**




EPF's 2017 thematic Campaign on Access to Healthcare for All calls on Member States and the EU to commit to a long-term vision where equity of access and universal health coverage is a reality for all patients in the EU – a target of the third UN Sustainable Development Goal on ensuring healthy lives.



Central Issues

1. Persistent **multi-dimensional barriers to access** for patients across the EU at individual, provider and health system level
2. The safety and **quality of healthcare** in the EU is unequal, and key aspects of patient centered healthcare are not implemented
3. **There is a lack of appropriate resources being efficiently invested in healthcare** e.g. restrictive policies, overburdened frontline health workforce, medicine shortages
4. Too many patients in the EU are confronted to **financial hardship** as a result of healthcare costs
5. Systematic **failure of European health systems** for many people living in this region, particularly **people in situations of precarity, social isolation or vulnerability**
6. **Health inequalities** within and between EU countries are **increasing**
7. Patients and informal carers are reporting experience of **discrimination and stigma** (on the grounds of health status or other) while seeking or receiving healthcare
8. Europe currently lacks **inter-sectoral action and collaboration** **for health**

Recommendations



Provide **equitable access to high-quality care** to all patients, regardless of which country they live in or their country of origin
